Submission Guidelines

- Art can be submitted in 4 categories:
 1. Painting
 2. Drawing
 3. Photography
 4. Other (sculpture, jewelry or graphic design)
- Up to 2 pieces may be submitted per applicant.
- Each submission must contain an Official Entry Form which should be attached to the back of the art.
- Sculptures should be no larger than 35"x35"x10".
- Hanging devices must be placed on artwork that is meant to be hung.
- Artwork must be original, not photocopied or reproduced.
- Artwork that includes vulgarity, excessive violence, or material considered offensive to any religious or ethnic groups, gender, or physically or mentally challenged persons will be disqualified.
- By submission, the artist grants permission for the Library to display, photograph and reproduce the submitted work for publicity purposes.
- The library will not be held responsible for lost or damaged work.
- To be eligible to win, teen must have a regular, property owner or fee Orange County Library card in good standing.
- Winners will be featured on the library's teen website, "it".
